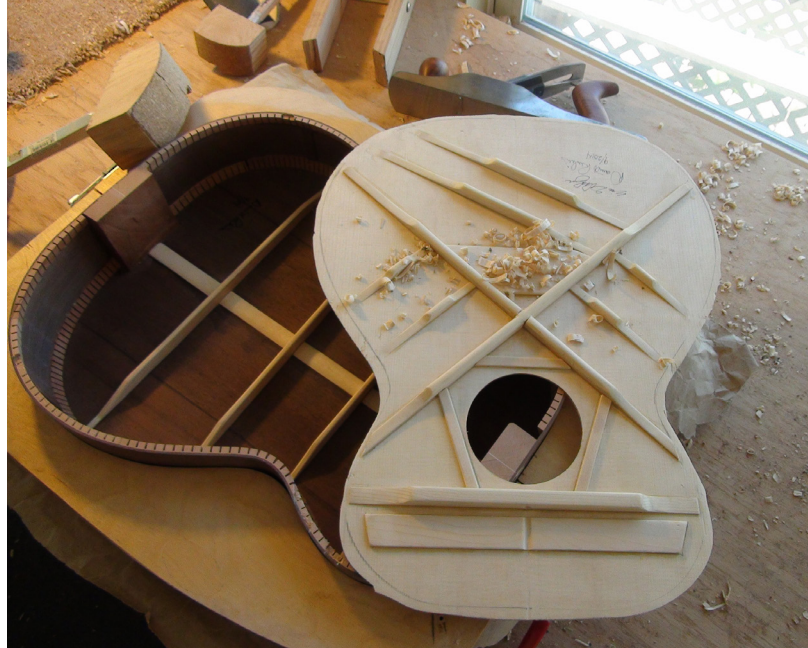


Make Your Own Acoustic Guitar 10-Day Workshop

During this 10-day workshop you will build your own flattop acoustic guitar out of exotic tone woods. Learn how to “voice” and brace the soundboard and back plate, carve the neck, slot and fret the fretboard, create a neck-to-body joint, and locate the bridge. Participants will also learn how to set up their guitar for good intonation and optimal playability.

This workshop is intensive and designed to teach the aspiring luthier and hobbyist how to start crafting fine instruments on their own. Participants can expect individualized attention throughout the course. No experience is necessary.

Eric Schaefer is a Luthier specializing in high quality, handcrafted, acoustic flattop guitars from exotic tone woods. The emphasis on the use of hand tools and traditional techniques is apparent in the construction of Eric’s guitars, mixing old-world craftsmanship with modern practices.
